

QUORN FOXHUNTERS RIDE

The course will be open for walking from the 2nd ^{of} November and every COMPETITOR MUST WALK the COURSE and no dogs allowed. The map will be on the Quorn website on the 1st November. The course starts to the East of Sherrards Covert (between Barrowcliffe Farm and Barsby Lodge) Parking for course walking is the 'Barrowcliffe Cross Country Course', What3Words are: ///leafing.daring.cuddled. The start field what3Words are: ///static.escaping.quaking

In addition to the start/finish there are a total of 5 markers, with red on your right and Blue on your left all of which must be complied with. The finish is in a field next to the Car and Lorry Park. Please assume that all gates will be closed on the day unless marked on the Gate. The markers are as follows:

MARKER 1 Red Marker in the hedgerow. MARKER 2 Blue Marker in the hedgerow. MARKER A Open Gate MARKER 3 Blue Marker in the hedgerow. MARKER B Open Gate MARKER 4 Blue Marker in the hedgerow. MARKER 5 Blue Marker by the Gate.

WIRE, the committee will make all effort to remove the wire from the course.

Will riders please make sure they are mounted and ready to leave the assembly point in the X-Country Field after the start of the Cross-Country Ride.

Declarations and Horse Numbers can be collected from the secretary situated in the Lorry Park between 10.00am and 11.30am. Reminder: rider numbers need to be printed and their own number bib provided.

Mounted stewards will then escort riders to the start.
